Chief Dudek reported that from July 1, 2009 through September 30, 2009 there were 33 Fire Calls and AMR responded to 89 Rescue calls. Membership for each department is: Fire-51 members and Rescue-16 members with an additional 6 applications pending. The Chief also stated that Fay Jose, a Fire and Rescue member, was recognized as the "Oldest EMT in Nebraska". The State Licensure Inspection for the Rescue Squad was discussed.
