ITEM 9 A

Craig Vincent, Nebraska Public Power District Account Manager gave a Power Point presentation updating the Mayor and Council on the LED Lighting Project via telephone. The advantages of LED street lighting were discussed and also the fact that the cost of the change from HPS (High Pressure Sodium) and VM (Mercury Vapor) to LED (Light Emitting Diode) would be paid for by Nebraska Public Power District.

Council member Porter introduced a resolution numbered and titled as follows: RESOLUTION NO. 17-001: Adopt Amendment No. 2 by and between the City of Plattsmouth and Nebraska Public Power District to extend the term of the Professional Retail Operations Agreement for a term of not less than fifteen (15) years, through March 31, 2032, and not more than twenty-five (25) years, through March 31, 2042.

Motion by Porter, seconded by Riese to adopt RESOLUTION NO. 17-001:

RESOLUTION NO. 17-001

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF PLATTSMOUTH APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO PROFESSIONAL RETAIL OPERATIONS AGREEMENT BETWEEN NEBRASKA PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH FOR THE PURPOSE OF

EXTENDING THE TERM, SETTNG AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND TO AUTHORIZE PUBLISHING NOTICE OF TRANSACTION.

WHEREAS, the City owns its electric distribution system, and

WHEREAS, the amendment to extend the term of the Professional Retail Operations Agreement on file with the Council has been proposed by Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD) and fully discussed and explained, and

WHEREAS, it is determined that it would be desirable to enter into said amendment to the Professional Retail Operations Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The said Amendment No. 2 to the Professional Retail Operations Agreement is approved and the Mayor is authorized to execute it, and the City Clerk to attest it on behalf of the City.
- 2. Notice of this transaction shall be given by publication once each week for three (3) successive weeks, of the following Notice:

NOTICE OF TRANSACTION

The Council has approved a Resolution authorizing execution on behalf of the City of an amendment to the Professional Retail Operations Agreement (Agreement) between Nebraska Public Power District and the City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska. The Agreement is on file with the City Clerk and available for inspection. It contains provisions summarized as follows:

- 1. The City will extend the lease of its electric distribution system to Nebraska Public Power District for a term of not less than fifteen (15) years from the effective date of the amendment and not more than twenty-five (25) years; provided, if either party terminates the Agreement at any time between year fifteen (15) and year twenty-five (25) of the term, the City will continue to take service from NPPD under NPPD's standard Wholesale Power Contract, and such Wholesale Power Contract shall remain in effect through the remainder of the twenty-five (25) year term.
- 2. During the term of the Agreement, NPPD will pay to the City an amount equal to twelve percent (12%) of the retail revenues from the electric distribution system, adjusted to eliminate revenues from tax-supported agencies, fuel cost, and similar adjustments. NPPD will maintain the electric distribution system, will make payments in lieu of taxes as required by law, and will provide insurance, as set out in the Agreement.

This Notice will be published in the Plattsmouth Journal once each week for three (3) successive weeks. If, within thirty (30) days after the last publication thereof, a referendum petition signed by qualified electors of the City equal in number to at least twenty percent (20%) of the votes cast at the last general municipal election shall be filed with the City Clerk, this

transaction shall not become effective until it has been approved by a vote of the electors. If no such petitions are filed, the transaction shall become effective at the expiration of said thirty (30) day period.
