AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF HIGHWAY ALLOCATION FUND PLEDGE AND REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 2021, OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA, IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,210,000) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING AND REDEEMING THE CITY'S HIGHWAY ALLOCATION FUND PLEDGE BONDS, SERIES 2012, DATED APRIL 5, 2012, PRESENTLY OUTSTANDING IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$475,000 AND TO PAY COSTS OF CONSTRUCTING CERTAIN STREET IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE CITY; PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF SAID BONDS; PLEDGING FUNDS TO BE RECEIVED BY THE CITY FROM THE STATE OF NEBRASKA HIGHWAY ALLOCATION FUND FOR THE PAYMENT OF SAID BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES TO PAY THE SAME IF NECESSARY; AUTHORIZING THE DELIVERY OF THE BONDS TO THE PURCHASER; PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF BOND PROCEEDS; AND ORDERING THE ORDINANCE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM.
