Craig Vincent, Account Manager for Nebraska Public Power District, gave a presentation on NPPD's diverse energy portfolio and their goal to be carbon net-zero by 2050. Mr. Vincent also highlighted their community involvement, incentive programs and their state-wide energy network. NO ACTION TAKEN.

Craig Vincent, Account Manager for Nebraska Public Power District, provided an update on the Sunwise Community Solar Program that was previously discussed at the January 16, 2023 council meeting. Since then, NPPD has assisted the City with the initial stages of Developer selection, explained the term and scope of contracts associated with the project and scheduled a tour of the solar facility in York, NE. Mr. Vincent cited that increases in supply chain lead time and construction costs have made this project less viable and is seeking Council's input on how to proceed. Following further discussion, Motion by Kerns seconded by Forrest to postpone indefinitely the proposed Sunwise Community Solar Program.
