On behalf of the City of Plattsmouth, you are encouraged to attend a public meeting to learn about the upcoming sanitary sewer project in your area.

The City of Plattsmouth is proceeding with the design and construction of a new sanitary sewer main along Lincoln Avenue from 2nd Avenue to 12th Avenue.

The project is part of a major City Waste Water Improvement Project resulting from the March 2019 flood event. The major project consists of the construction of a new wastewater treatment plant at Fourmile Industrial Park, new pumping stations and conveyance systems.

The project will be funded in part by FEMA, NEMA and the City.

Representatives from the City and the Engineering Firm will be available during the public meeting to answer questions regarding access, phasing, and impacts to adjacent properties.

### Lincoln Avenue Sanitary Sewer Improvements

Scope of Work

The improvements will include removal of the existing Lincoln Avenue street pavement, installation of the sanitary sewer pipe, storm sewer installation, water main replacements, and the reconstruction of the Lincoln Ave pavement along with new sidewalks, driveways, and ADA accessible ramps.

Phasing of the Work

The project will be constructed in several phases to minimize the disruption to residences and public access to Rhylander Park
