The Kass Kounty King Korn Klub is asking for the closing of the following streets for September 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11, 2011. These are the dates for The Plattsmouth Harvest Festival.

The Thomas & Thomas Amusements will be setting up their rides and booths on Sept. 7th on 4th Street to 1st Avenue and will tear down after midnight Sept. 11th. They will be using the City Parking Lot also during this time. The Midway will open Thursday afternoon.

Wednesday, September 7th – The stage will be positioned at 4th Street and Main in the AM. We will have Coronation practice after 6:00 pm. on Main Street from 5th Street to Stage at 4th Street. We should finish by 8:30pm.

Thursday, September 8th, we ask for the closing of Main Street at 3rd Street all day for access to the stage for members to complete work. Coronation participants will father between 5th Street and 6th Street on Main Street after 6:30pm. and the procession will begin at 5th Street and Main Street about 7:30pm and proceed to the stage at 4th Street and Main Street. The ceremony will last approximately 2 hours. This is the only activity taking place that will need street closings on Thursday.

Friday, September 9th, we ask for the closing of the following streets:

- 1. 3^{rd} Street to 4^{th} Street at Main Street all day for unloading equipment, etc. We will not need to eliminate business or apartment parking.
- 2. 4th Street between Avenue "A" and Main Street from 11:30 am. Until midnight because of groups loading and unloading equipment and for the parade route. The tractors will use this for their show after the parade.
- 3. Alley on north 5th street at Avenue "A" to alley at 5th Street and 1st Avenue from 7:30 am until midnight for Food Court/Flea Market and fund raising activities.
- 4. Main Street from 4th Street from 11:30am until midnight for scheduled events.
- 5. Avenue "A" from 5th Street to 4th Street form 11:30 am until 4:00 pm.
- 6. 6th Street from alley by Cass County Bank to 1st Avenue from 11:30 am until 9:00 pm for Kiddie Parade and activities following: Talent Show, Pep Rally, Lil Tuggers, Korn Eating Contest and the Kar Show which lines up at 5:00 pm. The Antique Tractor show and race will be starting at 4:00 pm in front of the stage. We will be having various activities during the afternoon on all of the closed streets.
- 7. We have a Kar Show and Shine until 9:00 pm on Main Street from 4^{th} Street thru 7^{th} Street and 1^{st} Avenue thru Avenue "A".

PLEASE NOTE: SATURDAY'S PARADE WILL BEGIN AT 5:30 P.M.

Saturday, September 10th, we are asking for the closing of the following streets:

- 1. 3^{rd} Street and Main Street to 4^{th} Street and Main Street 7:00 am to midnight for access to stage for various events. South 3^{rd} Street at 1^{st} Avenue to Main Street.
- 2. 5th Street from Avenue "A" to 1st Street for Fire and Rescue Department's displays and Food Court/Flea Market and fund raising activities from 7:30 am to midnight.
- 3. 5th Street from Avenue "A" north to Avenue "B" for parking of visiting fire and rescue equipment from 8:30 am. until after the parade.
- 4. 4th Street from Avenue "A" to Main Street from 8:30 am until after midnight, this is because of activities taking place on Saturday and for the parade route. Main Street from 4th Street to 7th Street from 8:30am until midnight. We have street activities starting at 10:00 am and continuing all day and evening.

There will be a Beer Tent on South 5th Friday and Saturday – September 9th and 10th.
