Mike Wilson, Fire Chief gave the 2009 Annual Report of the Plattsmouth Volunteer Fire Department/Rescue Squad. Wilson presented a handout that broke down the response percentages for each member. Wilson stated that the 2010 Fire Department Officers are: Mike Wilson-Chief; Bill Dudek-1st Assistant Chief; Brian Wuelling-2nd Assistant Chief; Stan Pasko-President; Bruce Johnson-Vice President; Eric Grimshaw-Secretary; and Jim Paczkowski-Treasurer. 2010 Rescue Officers are: Greg Clifton-Captain; Chris Peabody-1st Lieutenant; Joe Gradoville-2nd Lieutenant; Tad Smith-President; and Treasurer-contact City Treasurer. Wilson stated that the Fire Department has 49 members in good standing and there were 139 Fire Calls for the year 2009. Greg Clifton, Rescue Captain reported that from January 1, 2009 through October 13, 2009 the department responded to 317 calls. Since November 22, 2009 through December 10, 2009 the department had 10 Mutual Aide Calls: 9-Murray and 1-Bellevue. The Rescue Department has 19 members: 3 Paramedics; 10 EMT's; Remainder in-training; and 10 applications (one of which is already an EMT). Clifton also indicated that they are waiting for the Physician Medical Director to sign the protocols.
