PLATTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL December 6, 2010

A meeting of the City Council of the City of Plattsmouth, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 7:00 o'clock p.m. on December 6, 2010 at the City Hall in Plattsmouth Nebraska. Present were Council Members: John Porter, Terry Kerns, Mike Bowman, Terry Tilson, Ruth Wassinger, Rod Jenkins, Art Tesarek and Doug Derby. Also present: City Administrator Erv Portis, City Inspector Kevin Larson, City Treasurer Peggy Wilsey and City Attorney Roger Johnson.

Notice of this meeting was given in advance by publication in the Plattsmouth Journal. Proof of publication along with the Mayor and Council's Acknowledgment of Receipt of Notice are on file. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public.

The Mayor publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act and a copy of all documents being discussed at the meeting were available for inspection and indicated the location of such copies in the room where the meeting was being held.

Mayor Lambert read a December 6, 2010 letter of apology that was written to the Citizens of Plattsmouth by Michael Davis-VFW Post 2543 regarding the renaming of Pleasant Drive. The Mayor stated that Commander Davis' first letter, written and published in the news media, contained erroneous information, he felt that there was a lack of judgment on the part of Mr. Davis and considered the letter a personal slam toward the community and the family of a brave young man. Council Member Wassinger stated that last Thursday (12/2/2010) was one of the most challenging days she has had since being elected to the City Council. Wassinger made reference to the numerous e-mails and Facebook postings she received based on the erroneous information contained in Mr. Davis' letter to the citizens. Wassinger challenged the person who gave the erroneous information to come forward and admit the mistake. Wassinger also stated that one of the comments she received was "ashamed they knew me" and it was hard to take.
