## ITEM 8 A

Steven W. Perry, Olmsted & Perry Consulting Engineers Inc., City Engineer was present and reviewed the NDOR Highway 75 Project NH-75-2(155) Plattsmouth South of the Platte River Utility Relocations Project. Mr. Perry stated that 5 bids were received and they are listed on the Bid Tab Sheet in their packet and the recommendation is to approve the bid award and contract to General Excavating at a Base Bid unit price award of \$46,750.64. After discussion, motion by Porter, seconded by Tesarek to approve the bid award and contract to General Excavating for the NDOR Highway 75 Project NH-75-2 (155) Plattsmouth South of the Platte River Utility Relocations Project at a Base Bid unit price award of \$46,750.64 and authorize the Mayor to execute the construction contract. #### ITEM 9 A

Council Member Dugan introduced an ordinance numbered and titled as follows: Ordinance No. 1844- AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA TO AMEND THE PLATTSMOUTH REVISED MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES 2011, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 12, SECTION 2-1202 ENTITLED "MEMBERS; VACANCIES; MEETINGS" AS THE SAME RELATES TO THE CITIZEN ADVISORY REVIEW COMMITTEE OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE. City Administrator, Erv Portis stated that this ordinance amends the number of times per year that the Citizen Advisory Review Committee meets from 4 times to 2 times. Motion by Dugan, seconded by Porter to approved first reading of Ordinance No. 1844 by title only. ROLL CALL: Yes-Derby, Porter, Brookhouser, Tilson, Dugan and Tesarek. No-None. Absent-Kerns and Riese. Abstain. None. MOTION CARRIED. City Attorney, Roger Johnson read Ordinance No. 1844 in to the record by title only.

## ITEM 9 B

Council Member Dugan introduced an ordinance numbered and titled as follows: Ordinance No. 1845: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PLATTSMOUTH, NEBRASKA TO VACATE A PORTION OF WESTSIDE DRIVE AS DESCRIBED; TO PROVIDE FOR OWNERSHIP OF THE SAME TO REVERT TO THE ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNERS; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE. Motion by Dugan, seconded by Brookhouser that the statutory rule requiring reading an ordinance on three different days be suspended and that Ordinance No. 1845 be adopted on first reading by title only. Said ordinance was read by title only and thereafter Dugan moved for final passage of the ordinance, which motion was seconded by Tesarek.
