Joe Ostaseski, a representative of the Plattsmouth Economic Development Citizens Advisory Review Committee stated that Plattsmouth's Local Option Economic Development Plan (LB840) is operating as contemplated with the approved ordinance. Chris Koenig, HDR Engineering stated that Well No. 8 project was broke in to two (2) projects: 1-abandonment of Wells 1, 2 and 3 due to extensive damage from the 2011 Flood; and 2-build one (1) new well (Well No. 8) at a higher capacity to handle what all three abandoned wells (1, 2 & 3) were pumping.
