ITEM 9 B

Mike Wood, Plattsmouth Emergency Medical Services Director stated that there has been an increasing frequency in lift assist calls (which we do not bill for) from facilities licensed to provide nursing services. The liability placed on the department when responding to these types of calls at facilities with staff was questioned. The Standard Operating Procedure at one of the skilled facilities in Plattsmouth for lift assist is to call 911. Wood stated that the staff at the Plattsmouth EMS Department is licensed for Emergency Medical Services but are not licensed to

provide nursing services. The EMS Department does get lift assist calls from individuals that are at private residences and there is not a problem responding as there is not skilled staff on-site that should be assessing the patient for injury and is trained in lift assist. Mr. Wood stated that this is information to make the Council aware of the situation and to let them know that the situation will be monitored over the next few months for changes.
